Halloween can bring about excitement, fun and sweets. One of the best parts is the trick-ortreating! While it is fun for the children (& adults!), it could also be dangerous.

Please keep the our children safe by following these tips. If you are not chaperoning a child this year please be diligent by watching while you are driving. Kids can be fast!

- Be Visible—use a glow stick or a flashlight so people can see you
- Never go alone

components.

UL listings are a common topic of discussion in our world as electricians. Usually it comes up more often for sign installations as some townships require proof of a UL listing for illuminated signage.

However, the UL logo can be found on all electronic parts such as ballasts, breakers, etc. and it is important to be able to spot a fake listing (for obvious safety reasons).

There are four elements to a genuine UL mark.

- 1. the name and/or certification mark of Underwriters Laboratories (UL in a circle)
- 2. The word "LISTED" in capital letters

- 3. A product identity (what the product is)
- 4. A control number (four alpha-numeric characters) or issue number (typically 4-6 numbers)

While trying to be cost efficient, it is important that everyone remembers that safety always comes first!

SPOOKY YUMMY FUN

Ghosts in the Graveard Dessert Shooters

Ingredients

Filling

- 1 cup chocolate chips
- 175g cups heavy cream divided
- 8 oz cream cheese softened
- 28 Oreo Cookies pulverized in food processor
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

Whipped Cream Ghosts**

- 1 cup heavy cream
- 3/4 cup powdered sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Other optional toppings

- 12 Milano sandwich cookies
- 1 tube Black premade frosting for writing

Instructions

- In a small saucepan, combine 1 cup chocolate chips and 1/2 cup of the heavy cream over medium-low heat, stirring frequently until chocolate chips are completely melted and mixture is smooth.
- Remove from heat and pour into a heatproof bowl. Stir in vanilla extract.
- Allow mixture to cool completely before continuing.
- In a clean, medium-sized bowl, use an electric mixer to beat remaining 1 1/2 cups heavy cream to stiff peaks. Set aside.
- In bowl of stand mixer, combine cream cheese and (cooled) chocolate mixture, stirring until completely combined.

- Gradually add powdered sugar until completely combined. Scrape down sides of bowl as needed.
- Stir in vanilla extract and $1\ 1/2$ cups of the Oreo crumbs (reserve remaining crumbs to sprinkle over tops of shooters).
- Fold in whipped cream and then stir on low-speed until completely combined.
- Set out 24 disposable shot glasses.
- Pour mixture into large Ziploc bag, snip off one corner and pipe filling into shot glasses, filling about 3/4 full.
- Cover tops of each shooter with remaining Oreo crumbs.
- Prepare Milano cookies buy using black frosting to write "RIP" on upper half of cookie.
- Press Milano cookies firmly into half of the shooters so that only the half of the cookie reading "RIP"

is protruding (like tombstones)

Ghosts

- Prepare whipped cream ghosts by combining heavy cream, powdered sugar, and vanilla in clean medium-sized bowl and whisking until stiff peaks form. (You may instead skip this step and use Cool Whip).
- Pour whipped cream (or Cool Whip) into large

piping bag fitted with a large round tip and pipe ghost-shaped swirls on top of the remaining half of dessert shooters.

- Use black frosting to gently draw eyes and mouths on ghosts
- Serve & enjoy!
