REPLACING APARTMENT PANELS

We recently bid a job for a large apartment community to upgrade the apartment units' electrical panels and breakers. There are 8 buildings containing 144 units total.

They needed to have the panels moved for code purposes. The apartments also needed to have their breakers in the main metering banks upgraded.





We were awarded the work and began the process in October 2016. We are expected to have it completed by the end of April 2017.

The old style panel can be seen on the left. The new

updated panels with a clearly written panel schedule can be seen in the upper right corner.

During the first site survey it was found that different buildings had different type of fuses throughout the property. Our suggestion was to replace all fuses to the same type.

Due to the extensive type of work being done, permits with



engineered drawings were required by the township. An inspection will also be needed once the work is completed.

President's Day

In the middle ages Valentine's greetings were popular, but written greetings didn't appear until after 1400. The oldest known valentine in existence is a poem written in 1415 by Charles, Duke of Orleans, to his wife while he was imprisoned in the Tower of London.
